private collection and a group of Chinese and Korean helmets from an English private collection. This will also be **Rasti Chinese Art**'s first showing at the fair, with an exhibition titled 'Transforming Traditions' and consisting of Chinese lacquer furniture, Japanese lacquersmiths' work pieces, calligraphy by Yuichi Inoue and paintings by Wang Mansheng. One of their highlights is a 20th century Japanese lacquersmith's work table.

Kaikodo will be participating again this year, with the exhibition 'Chinese Paintings from the Kaikodo Collection'. As well as antique Chinese paintings, the

gallery specializes in bronzes, sculptures, Tibetan paintings, textiles and Himalayan works of art.

Rossi & Rossi will be showing sculptures, bronzes and paintings from China, India, Mongolia, Nepal and Tibet, among other Asian works. Of especial interest are a monumental 13th–14th century copper-alloy figure of Avalokiteshvara from Nepal, standing 88.9 centimetres high and bearing traces of inlaid semi-precious stones, and a larger-than-lifesized polychrome stucco head of the Buddha from Gandhara, circa 3rd century. One of Tenzing Asian Art's highlights is a dignitary's seal, similar in shape
